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# A CASE STUDY ON ICHTHYOSIS VULGARIS AND ITS HOLISTIC HEALING AT DR BATRA'S

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## **Abstract**

Ichthyosis vulgaris is one of the most common hereditary skin disorders, characterized by dry, rough skin with fine or thick scaling. The condition usually begins in childhood and may persist or fluctuate in severity throughout life. Conventional management relies on emollients, keratolytics, and topical agents that provide temporary symptomatic relief but often fail to address the underlying predisposition or prevent recurrences. In homeopathy, chronic skin diseases are approached constitutionally, considering the totality of symptoms—physical, mental, and general—along with miasmatic background. This case study highlights the journey of a 17-year-old boy suffering from ichthyosis vulgaris. Over a period of sustained homeopathic treatment at Dr Batra's, his skin condition improved remarkably, not only limited to the physical sphere but also extended to his general health and mental outlook.

## Introduction

Ichthyosis vulgaris is a genetically determined keratinization disorder caused by mutations in the filaggrin gene, leading to impaired epidermal barrier function and abnormal desquamation [1]. It typically presents during early childhood with fine, dry, polygonal scales, most prominently on the trunk and extensor surfaces, while flexural areas are often spared. The severity tends to fluctuate with seasons, often worsening in winters due to low humidity and improving in humid climates [2].

Common signs and symptoms include generalized xerosis, thick scaling, itching, and rough texture of the skin. Secondary complications such as eczema, recurrent infections, and cosmetic disfigurement can affect quality of life and psychosocial development, especially in adolescents [3]. Diagnosis is primarily clinical, supported by family history and occasionally genetic testing. Conventional treatment focuses on hydration and exfoliation of skin using emollients, keratolytics, and topical retinoids, which provide temporary relief but seldom address recurrence [4].

Homeopathy views ichthyosis as a chronic miasmatic disorder, requiring constitutional treatment for long-term improvement. By considering the totality of symptoms—physical generals, mental state, modalities, and miasmatic background—remedies are selected to restore balance at a deeper level. This case report discusses the presentation, management, and outcome of a patient with ichthyosis vulgaris under homeopathic care.

## Case Profile

The boy, a 17-year-old student of class 12th, has been suffering from **ichthyosis vulgaris** since 2021, when he was in class 9th. His condition mainly affects his back and chest, where thick, dry scales appear, especially during the summer season. The dryness is severe, and the scales come out easily, often causing pain and itching when removed. Heat and sweating make the problem worse, while being in a cool environment like air-conditioning provides relief. Moisturizers and allopathic medicines give him only temporary improvement. Over time, his symptoms fluctuate—sometimes clearing up completely, and at other times recurring with dryness, scaling, and itching. Along with this, he occasionally develops acne and has also faced episodes of fungal infection in the thighs. Despite his condition, he continues with his schoolwork and judo practice, though he sometimes feels low in confidence and is upset about his disease. He is otherwise calm in nature, friendly, and shares things with his parents. His health problems cause him irritation and discomfort during sweating, but he feels better when the skin is clear. Overall, his journey with the skin disease has been marked by phases of suffering, temporary relief, and recurrence, which affects both his physical comfort and emotional well-being.

The boy is generally introverted and reserved, yet he has a friendly nature and easily makes connections with close people. He prefers good company and consciously avoids the company of bad influences. Though he usually remains calm and composed, his skin condition sometimes makes him irritable, but he does not express anger openly and tends to keep his emotions within. His confidence is average, occasionally lowered due to his health problems, but overall he manages his studies and hobbies well. He has no particular fears and feels comfortable in the presence of his family and friends. He desires the company of sweetnatured people, enjoys listening to Punjabi music, watching automobile content on YouTube, and practicing judo. His nature is simple, friendly, and sensitive, with a tendency to get upset due to his recurring skin troubles.
